About IIPHG

IIPHG was set up as a joint initiative of the Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) and the Government of Gujarat in 2008. IIPHG is "India's First Public Health University" established under the IIPHG Act-2015 of Gujarat State. IIPHG has become a leading institution in India's public health education, training, research and advocacy. IIPHG has collaborations with Indian and international organizations of global repute for advancing public health research. IIPHG work with various central and state government partners, multilateral organizations like the World Health Organization (WHO), and international academic partners from Germany, Sweden, Australia and the United States of America. In addition, IIPHG is a Centre of Excellence: Nutrition and a Technical Support Unit to PM POSHAN scheme in Gujarat and has student innovations centre at its lush green 50-acre campus on the banks of river Sabarmati in Gandhinagar. With a rich research portfolio of more than 500 research publications, the diverse faculty of the institute bring contemporary learning to the classrooms.

Faculty

The faculty members, holding advanced qualifications in the fields of public health, social science, management, Health Economics, finance, pharmaceuticals and medicine, etc., from reputed Indian and foreign universities. In addition to teaching, the faculty spend considerable time in academic research, training, advocacy, and public health practice in the diverse areas of public health and healthcare management. IIPHG faculty undertake externally funded research projects in the area of their expertise and disseminate new knowledge through research publications, policy briefs, presentations at conferences, and consultations. Based on years of academic experience, the faculty strives to upgrade the curriculum, improve the teaching materials, and enrich classroom discussions. In addition to regular faculty, several public health experts from governmental and nongovernmental organisations (NGOs) from India and abroad also contribute to IIPHG's teaching programmes as visiting and adjunct faculty.



M.Sc. in Public Health Nutrition Programme at IIPHG

This program seeks to produce adept nutrition professionals who can critically analyze, strategize, and lead initiatives that alleviate nutrition-related disparities, promote healthier lifestyles, and ultimately enhance the well-being of communities. Such nutrition professionals shall support the nutrition field, as a trained cadre of nutrition professionals to government, and non-government (international/national NGOs, training institutes etc.) to contribute to large-scale implementation of national flagship health, foods & nutrition programs. The program shall also develop the capacities of the students in research related to the field of public health nutrition, wherein students shall conduct in-depth original research or conduct operations in public health nutrition in conjunction with the coursework.

Eligibility

This course is intended for freshers as well as individuals working in the nutrition sector who intend to develop themselves professionally in the field of public health nutrition. Graduates from medical and paramedical background including dentistry, Indian Systems of Medicine, graduates in Veterinary/Nursing Sciences, Bachelor of Physiotherapy, Bachelor of Occupational Therapy, Bachelor of Pharmacy, or students with graduation degree in basic life science, biotechnology, biochemistry, family and community science, home science (food & nutrition as major subject), dietetics, food science and quality control, food and nutrition, and/or microbiology can apply.

The post-graduates in M.Sc. (PHN) would be competent in techno-managerial capacity for nutrition. Through this course, the professionals will be capable of positioning themselves at programmatic managerial levels in:

Assured scholarship of 30%-50% is available which will be offered to deserving candidates.

Hostel Fees

Limited hostel facility in the form of 140 single-occupancy, non-AC hostel rooms with attached toilets and balcony is available at the cost of **Rs. 33,000** per semester. There are separate hostel blocks for girls and boys. A cafeteria serving nutritious food is available. The approximate cost of food will be **Rs. 6000** per month.
