Eligibility

The program is open to candidates with a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognised university in India or abroad, with at least 50% marks. Public health is a multidisciplinary area and applicants from diverse academic backgrounds such as medical and paramedical sciences, biological sciences, veterinary sciences, management, social work, engineering, law, commerce, accounting, communication, etc. are eligible to apply. Relevant work experience in the health and development sector will be an added advantage.

Admission Process

Selection of candidates is based on the past academic performance, screening test score, professional working experience, and personal interview.

Tuition Fee for MPH Program

Indian nationals (Including Nepal & Bhutan) Rs. 2,75,000 per annum

SAARC country students US \$ 10,000 per annum*

International students US \$ 13,200 per annum*

*The tuition fee does not include the cost of candidate's accommodation, food, and other on-campus or offcampus student welfare activities.

Hostel Fees

Limited hostel facility in the form of 140 single-occupancy, non-AC hostel rooms with attached toilet and balcony is available at the cost of Rs. 33,000 per semester. There are separate hostel blocks for girls and boys. A cafeteria serving nutritious food is available. The approximate cost of food will be Rs. 6000 per month.

Scholarships

The scholarships were awarded to 25% of the students. There are limited number of scholarships available which will be offered to deserving candidates after a rigorous selection process.
