# Admissions 2026

## Eligibility

- Bachelor's degree in any discipline (Medical, Paramedical, Management, Social Sciences, Engineering, Law, Commerce, Arts, Statistics, Life Sciences, and Allied Backgrounds)
- Minimum 50% marks from recognized university
- Work experience in health, development, research, or allied sectors is an added advantage
- Final-year undergraduate students awaiting results can also apply (subject to submission of proof before programme commencement)

## Selection Process

**Transparent, and Competitive Selection**  
Admissions are conducted through a fair and merit-based process to ensure equal opportunity for all applicants.

**Two-Stage Evaluation Process**  
Selection is based on a review of academic performance, a screening test, and a personal interview process.

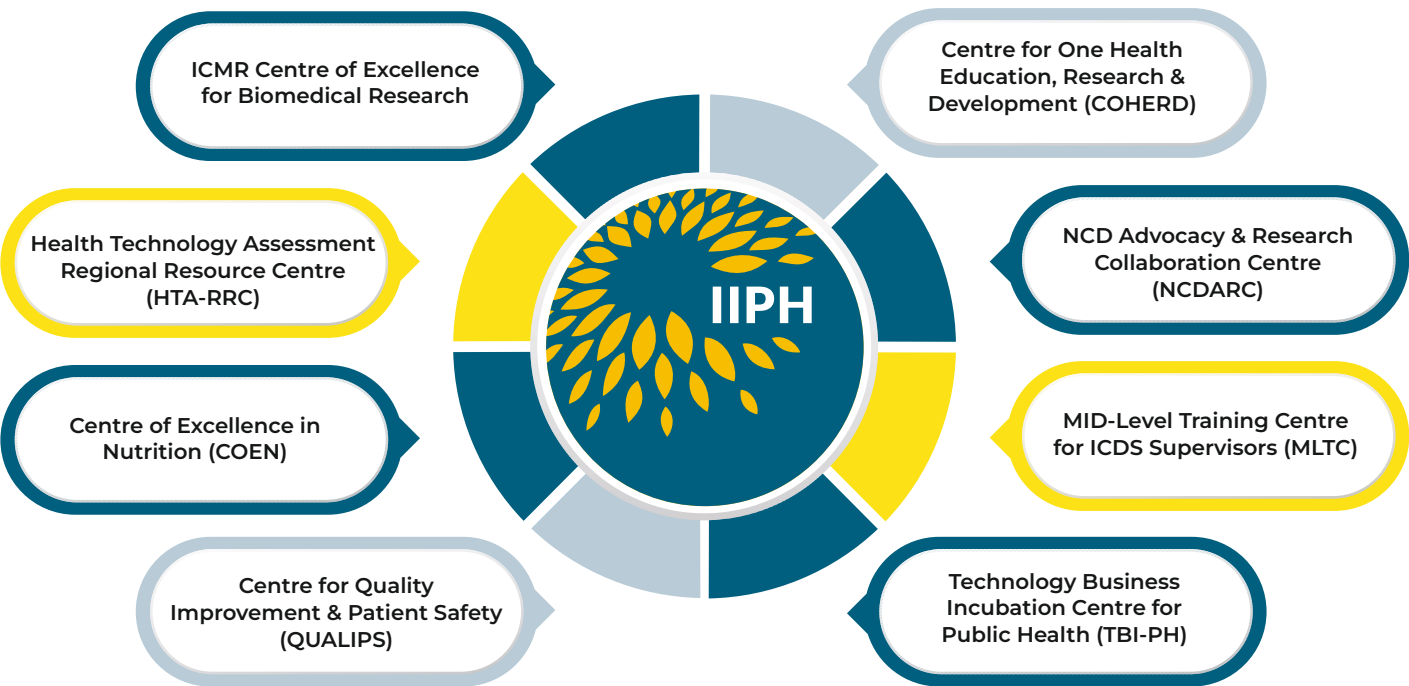
