Subject: Formation of University Student Grievance Redressal Committee (USGRC)

Under clause (f) of Section 2 of the UGC Act, 1956 of University Student Grivance Redressal & UGC (grievance Redressal) Regulation, 2012 & AICTE (Redressal of Grivance of students0 regulations, 2019. A USGR-Ccommittee with following members is formed for smoothening the process for Grivance Redressal.

- 1. A complaint from an aggrieved student relating to the institution shall be addressed to the chairperson, Student Griveance Redressal Committee (USGRC).
- 2. USGRC includes following members;
 - Dr. Mahaveer Golechha, Professor, Chairman
 - Dr. Anish Sinha, Associate Professor & IC-Registrar
 - Dr. Somen Saha, Professor
 - Dr. Jallavi Panchamia, Assocaite Professor
 - Dr. Bharti Sharma, Associate Proessor
 - Dr. Komal Shah, Associate Professor
 - A representative from among students of the university to be nominated by the Director based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular Activities-Special Invitee.
- 3. The chairperson and members of the committee shall have a term of two years.
- 4. The quorum for the meeting including the chairman, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
- 5. The USGRC shall send its report with recommendation to the aggrieved student, within a period of 15 days from the date of recipt of the complaint.
- Any student aggrieved by the decision of the USGRC may prefer an appeal to the ombudsperson, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such decision.

The USGRC committee will assist university in following;

- a. Students Grivance Related to Admission, Selection, withdrawl, fees & refund process
- b. Academic and non academic Grivance
- c. Non transparent or Unfair evaluation practices
