In 2016, IIPHG relocated to a 50-acre green campus in Gandhinagar, featuring cutting-edge research facilities. Recognized as India's first public health university under the IIPHG Act-2015 of Gujarat State, the institute is dedicated to advancing public health education, training, research, and advocacy, with a mission to enhance the nation's health system.

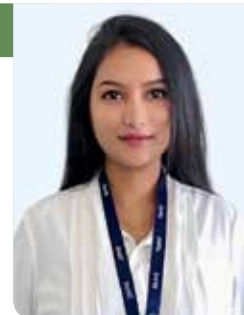

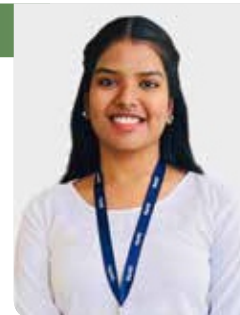

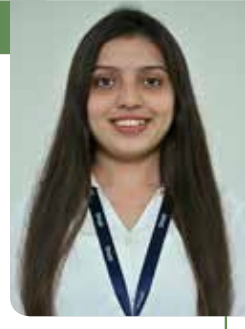
