### **Project Brief**

IIPHG received a grant from the Department of Health Research, Government of India to establish a Regional Resource Centre for Health Technology Assessment. The purpose of HTA is to support informed policymaking, and economic evaluation forms one of the core components of HTA studies. The Regional Resource Centre for Health Technology Assessment (HTA RRC) will contribute to establish transparent and comprehensive mechanism of HTA for prudent and better allocation of resources ensuring better equity in and access to healthcare in India. Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan will be the key focus states.
